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GUIDELINES FOR CRAFTERS

DATE: SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 10, 2022. **THERE IS NO RAINDATE.** This is a one-day outdoor event, rain or shine. NO REFUNDS.

PLACE: Crafters registration entrance is on South St, PAST the Brielle Library, which is at 610 South St, Brielle, NJ 08730

TIME: The show opens at 9 AM and closes at 4 PM. Set up time and registration time will be communicated at a later date. AS PER TOWN ORDINANCE: No vehicle movement on the field after 9 AM or before 4 PM. Break down must start at 4 PM. All vehicles must be off the field by 5:30 PM.

TENTS & CANOPIES: All Tents, Umbrellas, Canopies are required to be secured to the ground with either stakes or weights. Conveniently, your car may stay with you if it fits within your 14 x 26 foot space. Large vehicles must use two spaces or use the parking lot.

SPACE ASSIGNMENTS: Depending on field setup, if you exhibited in 2021, you will be assigned the same space unless you request a change on your application in the space provided. We cannot guarantee your choice of a specific new space if so requested.

FEE: \$100 per assigned 14 x 26 foot space if postmarked by July 15.

IN the event that all available spaces are filled before July 15, entries will be closed at that time.

This will be posted on our website (www.thewomansclubofbrielle.org). We encourage you to enter early.

We do not refund any entry fees for any reason.

THE REGISTRATION DEADLINE IS JULY 15. CONTRACTS POSTMARKED AFTER THIS DATE WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

The signed Contract and Payment must be received before the application will be processed. IF YOUR APPLICATION IS REJECTED FOR ANY REASON, WE WILL CONTACT YOU BY EMAIL AND YOUR CHECK WILL BE DESTROYED.

PAYMENT: Please make check payable to: **The Woman's Club of Brielle/BD**, and mail to: **Post Office Box 502, Brielle, NJ 08730** together with this signed contract and photos, if required. Your mailed copy should have your original signature on it. Keep a copy for yourself.

ELIGIBILITY: We are looking for quality crafts representing a wide variety of craft categories. The finished products must reflect a high level of skill. ALL ITEMS MUST BE HANDCRAFTED, PAINTED, OR PHOTOGRAPHED BY THE EXHIBITOR OR UNDER THEIR DIRECT SUPERVISION. COMMERCIAL

PRODUCTS MAY NOT BE SOLD. WE WILL LIMIT THE NUMBER OF CRAFTERS IN EACH CATEGORY. **RESELLERS OR CRAFT SUPPLIERS ARE NOT ELIGIBLE.** We encourage crafters to demonstrate their crafts, if practical.

We also encourage people who do children's activities to apply to participate.

We reserve the right to refuse admittance to anyone who has misrepresented their craft on their contract, and we will ask you to remove any merchandise we do not consider to be handcrafted.

Please note: this has become a juried show, however, we have grandfathered vendors who have been with us for years who do not meet new criteria.

Those who have sold items not acceptable and have been asked to refrain from selling them in the past are prohibited from selling them again.

Determination of eligibility is at the discretion of the Brielle Day Craft Fair Committee.

COMMUNICATIONS: We communicate mainly by **EMAIL.** We need you to take responsibility for receiving and answering these emails. **Please add BrielleDayWomansClubOfBrielle@gmail.com to your approved senders list.** We do not have the manpower to follow-up individually with people who do not read and respond to emails.

We may also make **general announcements using MailChimp.** Please do not ignore MailChimp communications.

FOOD VENDORS:

- All food must be prepackaged except for freshly made popcorn and gourmet coffee. Bring a copy of your health certificate with you.
- Freshly grown goods must be grown locally.
- We must be notified ahead of time if any flammable material (e.g. propane) is going to be used.

LIMITATIONS

- No open flames (e.g. candles) allowed on site.
- Spaces may NOT be sublet to any other craft vendor.
- Spaces may be shared if both crafters involved have submitted contracts and been juried by the Brielle Day Committee.
- All displays must be kept within your outlined space. At no time may any tables, racks, etc. be moved out into the aisles.

At no time will ANY games of chance be allowed to be held by any crafter. All games of chance are against our municipal laws. Law-enforcement will be called to remove you from the craft show.

LIABILITY: All responsibility is assumed by the crafter and/or the person who registers. The Borough of Brielle, The Woman's Club of Brielle and volunteers will not be responsible for any damage to or loss of property or work displayed. If I am injured or hurt in any way, I will not make a claim to bring suit against The Borough of Brielle, The Woman's Club of Brielle or volunteers. The Woman's Club of Brielle reserves the right to close any exhibit it deems offensive and/or questionable to the general public. Please use discretion and keep in mind that this is an event where families will be in attendance.
